4. What do you think Martha had in mind when she said, "I know that even now God will give you whatever you ask" (v. 22)?
5. What situations may cause us to be disappointed with God?

6. What does Jesus mean when he says the person who believes in him will live, even though he dies (v. 25)?

7. Now look again at verse 26. Can those who believe in Jesus expect that they will never die? Explain what Jesus means.

8. If Jesus is the resurrection and the life, how would you describe the life we have right now when we believe in him?

9. What assurance do Jesus' words give you about your death and life beyond death?

10. What "deathlike" situations in your life can Jesus' resurrection power change?

How will Jesus' words change the way you pray for those who are going through a difficult time?
