#### Bible Study Questions 11-2-2022

1. What caused the people to be filled with wonder and amazement?
2. How does the response of the people to this miracle contrast with that of the beggar (vv. 8, 11-12)?
3. How do you usually respond to the amazing acts of God?
4. What is the significance of the fact that they found the crippled man at the temple gate?
5. When Peter saw the response of the crowd, he saw his opportunity and talked to them about Jesus. According to Peter's message, what had God done to Jesus (vv. 13-15)?

What had the Jews done to him?

6. How is the authority of Jesus demonstrated in this miracle (v. 16)?
7. What do you think it meant that "complete healing" (v. 16) was given to the beggar?

What healing do you need in your life?

8. How did Peter explain that all that had happened to Jesus was a part of God's plan (vv. 17-26)?
  
9. Focus on verse 21. The wait for Jesus to return from heaven may seem very long-but this verse gives us some perspective. What are your thoughts and feelings about waiting for Jesus to return?
  
10. To what extent does God's Word affect your confidence, actions and attitudes about God and life?
  
11. How do you respond when you have opportunities like Peter's to talk about Jesus?
  
12. In summary, how is the power of the Holy Spirit linked to the truth about Jesus in this passage?
  
13. The "completely" healed man was a powerful testimony to the power of God and the truth of Peter's words. How have you seen the power of God demonstrated in your life and in the lives of others?
